CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR PARENTS & PARTICIPANTS OF SCHOOL SPORTS & GENERAL AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS.

We are fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all our pupils. Warden House believes it is important that pupils, staff, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the school should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with either the Principal or sports co ordinator.

As a member of a Warden House sports and general after school clubs you are expected to abide by the following club rules:

- All members must participate within the rules and respect club leaders, judges and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents and fellow club members.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for clubs and competitions or inform their club leader. No more than 3 sessions should be missed (not applicable if unwell or are attending another school activity)
- Parents and Members should inform the club leader or the school office if they are unable to attend the club.
- Members attending a sports associated club must wear suitable attire for training (school uniform and shoes are not allowed) as agreed with the coach. Keep long hair tied back.
 Remove all body jewellery.
- Fees must be paid promptly at the beginning of each term.
- Members should treat all equipment with respect.
- Members must not use bad language.
- Members should remain with club leader at the end of a session until collected by their parent or guardian.
- Members should be collected from clubs at the stated finishing time. If they are not they will be sent to the Jungle After School Club which will be chargeable to you.
