# Attendance Update

Warden House Primary School is committed to the continuous raising of achievement of all our pupils. Regular attendance is critical if our pupils are to be successful and benefit from the opportunities presented to them.

#### Points to remember:

- ♣ Our School gates close at 8.55am, after this time your child will be late and will need to go through the school office and sign in.
- ♣ Your child is required to attend school EVERY DAY. If your child is too poorly to attend and is taken to the doctors, please bring a note into school if possible.
- ♣ Phone the school EVERY morning that your child does not attend, before 9.00am, to ensure their attendance records are kept and up to date. You can also leave a message or send a text. Please be clear about the reason, do not just say unwell or ill. Please only keep them at home if it is absolutely necessary.
- We require 24 hour notice of a medical appointment for your child. You should bring evidence of the appointment such as an appointment card or text into the school office as soon as possible.
