Word:	To be able to convert nouns or adjectives into verbs by using suffixes (E.gate; _ise; _ify)	
	To form verbs by using a range of prefixes (E.g. DIS_; DE_;MIS_;OVER_; RE_)	
Sentence:	To identify and use relative clauses beginning with (E.g. WHO, WHICH, WHERE, WHEN, WHOSE, THAT)	
	To indicate degrees of possibility using adverbs (E.g. perhaps; surely)	
	To identify and use a range of different tense types in writing (progressive, perfect and simple forms)	
	To indicate degrees of possibility using modal verbs (E.g. might, should, dare, must, will, could)	
Text:	To use a range of conjunctions as devices to build cohesion within a paragraph	
	To link ideas across paragraphs by making informed decisions about tense choices	
	To be able to link ideas by using adverbials of time, place and number.	
Punctuation:	To be able to use brackets, dashes and commas to indicate parenthesis	
	To be able to use commas to clarify meaning or avoid ambiguity
