

1633	Samuel Pepys is born.	
1665	The Great Plague (The Black Death).	
1666	The Great Fire of London.	
1703	Samuel Pepys dies.	
1820	Florence Nightingale is born.	
1820	Harriet Tubman is born.	
1853	The Crimean War begins.	
1856	The Crimean War ends.	
1861	The American Civil War.	
1863	Under General Montgomery of the Union Army, Harriet led an armed raid, the first ever by a woman and she freed over 700 slaves.	
1910	Florence Nightingale dies.	
1913	Harriet Tubman dies.	

Key Vocabulary and Phrases		
Diary	A book for keeping a record of experiences and thoughts	
London	The capital city of England.	
Nurse	A person skilled or trained in caring for sick or injured people.	
Slave	A person who is owned by another person and can be sold at the owner's will.	
Culture	The habits, beliefs, and traditions of a certain people.	
Significant	Likely to have an influence or effect on something.	
Compare	To look at (two or more things) closely in order to see what is similar or different about them.	
Chronology	The order in which things happen.	
Past	A time gone by.	
Artefact	Any object made or shaped by human hand.	
Evidence	A sign which shows that something exists or is true.
