1491	Henry VIII born.
1509	Henry VIII is crowned at Westminster Abbey.
1509	Henry VIII marries Catherine of Aragon.
1517	Martin Luther publishes 95 theses against the Roman Catholic Church.
1520	Meeting between Henry VIII and Francis the first at the Field of the Cloth of Gold.
1533	Henry VIII marries Anne Boleyn.
1533	Birth of Princess Elizabeth, later to be Elizabeth I.
1536	Dissolution of the smaller monasteries.
1536	Henry VIII marries Jane Seymour.
1540	Henry VIII marries then divorces Anne of Cleves.
1540	Henry VIII marries Catherine Howard.
1543	Henry VIII marries Catherine Parr.
1547	Henry VIII dies.
1547	Elizabeth's younger half-brother becomes King Edward VI aged

Key Vocabulary and Phrases	
Reformation	A period of change. Started by Henry VIII when he decided to split the English church away from the Pope and become the Head of the Church of England.
Monastery	A building or buildings occupied by a community of monks living under religious vows.
Dissolution	The action of formally ending or dismissing an assembly, partnership, or official body.
Catholic	The oldest and largest branch of Christianity ruled over by the Pope in Rome.
Protestant	The second largest branch Christianity that became separate from the Catholic church in the 16th century. Protestants don't have the Pope as their leader.
Successor	A person who inherits the throne after the death of the previous king or queen.
Monarch	A sovereign head of state, especially a king, queen or emperor.
Reign	Rule as monarch over a country.
Political	Relating to the government or public affairs of a country.
Consequence	As a result of something.
