### **Curriculum:**

Our Maths plan will continue to follow the White Rose program and our English will be based on set pieces of literature. This term we will be reading two class books: 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes; and 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. ### Homework:

Our homework will consist of daily reading, weekly spelling (sent home on Friday and tested on the following Friday) and a weekly times table practice – the times table of the week will be written at the top of the spelling sheet sent home with your child.

Please support your child with their reading each day and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated each time. This is important as it enables us to monitor your child's reading and ensure they are making progress. Even more able readers benefit from reading aloud to an adult from time to time as this helps really develop their understanding of punctuation and meaning.

### **Multiplication Check:**

In Year 4, the children will sit a government multiplication check in June that will test their rapid recall of all of their times tables up to 12 x 12. Your support in practicing these at home would be gratefully appreciated. There are many websites to support this, including; Hit the Button, Timetable Rockstars and UrBrainy. These are all great websites that we encourage all children to use, to develop their multiplication knowledge.
