### **Community Tennis**




The LTA are offering FREE weekly tennis sessions from this Saturday down at Marke Wood park between 10-11am. Click here to book as needed.

## Accelerated Reader "Home Connect"

For our children who have moved onto the Accelerated Reader scheme in school, did you know that as parents you can use your child's login to monitoring their progress as they take their reading quizzes?

To access this, visit "<u>Accelerated Reader Home Connect</u>,". Use your child's login details (usually inside your child's reading record). Once logged in, you can view their current points target; how many books they have read, their total percentage score and much more.

There is even an option to setup email alerts every time your child completes a quiz in school. Should you have any questions or cannot find your child's login, please speak to their teacher.
