English and Phonics

Expressive Arts and Design

Explore, use, and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings. Music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.

Use materials and colours purposefully and with control.

Communication and Language

Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences. Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives. Engage in non-fiction books to familiarise with new knowledge and vocabulary.

Maths

Our Maths lessons this term children will learn to recognize numbers from 0 to 10. They will explore different concepts such as comparing mass, finding balance, exploring and comparing capacity.

Managing Self

This term children will be working on increasing their Independence in different tasks and their own learning.

Children will be encouraged to communicate effectively – listen, speak, reflect. respond.
