In RE this term, we will be finding out why Jesus is so inspiring to some and at the difference he has made to some, looking at stories such as Feeding the 5000.

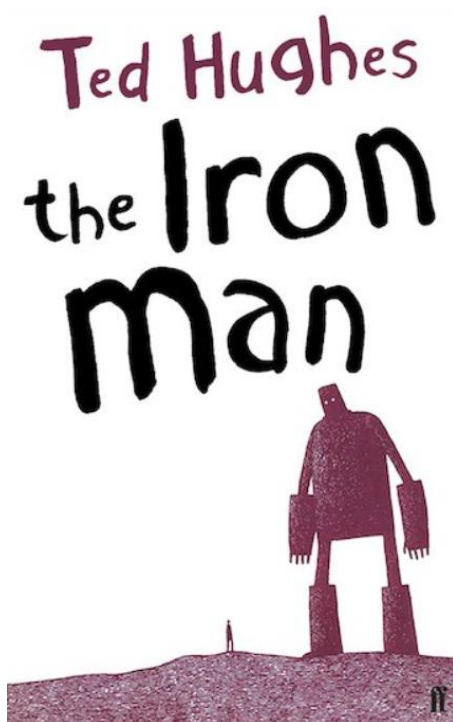
### PE
