Welcome back to term 6! Below are a few messages and reminders:

PE

English

This term the children will be studying a film unit called 'Treasure'. The children will be expanding their vocabulary and developing a persuasive piece of writing. We will also be recapping our topic on 'light'. The children will use their prior knowledge to write an explanation.

Maths

The children will be building on their knowledge of time and solving problems. We will also be covering shape, rotation, angle (right angles, obtuse, acute) and statistics. The children will learn to collect and interpret data, answer questions, draw pictograms, bar charts and two-way tables.

History

The children will be learning about the ancient Greeks. They will learn about the life of children in ancient Greece, the Olympic Games, artefacts and ancient buildings.

Computing

The children will create their own book trailer. They will develop storyboards, import videos and images, use editing software, incorporate transitions in videos and evaluate their work.

RE

Children will learn about Christian scriptures – the Bible – exploring questions about what the Bible says and how the Bible is used and valued in Christian communities today.

French

In this unit we will learn 10 fruits and be introduced to the simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'. By the end of the unit children will have the knowledge and skills to be able to say which fruits they like and do not like.

DT

We will be learning to understand pneumatic systems, design and make a pneumatic toy, decorate and assemble their toy and test and finalise ideas against design criteria.

PE

This term the children doing athletics. We will be doing short and long distance running, long jump, correct technique for overhead throw and javelin. We have tennis coaching on Fridays.

PSHE

This term's topic is 'changing me'. We will cover how babies change and grow, inside and outside body changes, family stereotypes and looking ahead and forward to change.

Music

The children will be introduced to traditional Indian music and instruments, improvise with given notes, creating a piece of music using drone, rag and tal and performing.
