- Spelling Shed games/ spelling practise each week ahead of weekly Friday spelling tests.

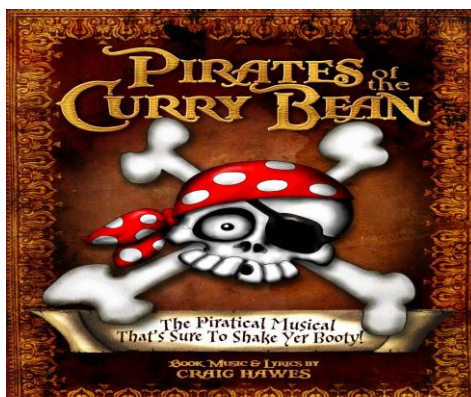

### English

This term we will be researching and investigating significant aspects from the decades of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Year 6 writing and grammatical features will also be applied to the children's independent pieces of writing and they will also focus on their presentation and organisation of written work.

### Maths

Investigating real life problems through project work. These projects provide an opportunity to revisit many of the skills and curriculum content covered both in Year 6 and also the rest of Key Stage 2. This gives pupils the opportunity to ensure any possible gaps in understanding are addressed before they move on to secondary school.

### Design and Technology

This term we will be designing, making and evaluating waistcoats. This will incorporate various sticking skills and techniques associated with garment making.

### Religious Education

This term, children will investigate 'Green Religion' – how and why should religious communities do more to care for the Earth?

### Music

This term the children will compose and perform compositions linked to the theme of a production. They will also explore various musical styles and techniques through the medium of pop art.

### PSHE

This term's PSHE topic is 'Changing Me.' The children will further develop their knowledge and understanding of physical and emotional changes that they may experience at this stage of their development and as they become adults. They will also explore the concept of positive and negative relationships and the behaviour that goes with this.

### PE
