

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome to Term 6! I can't believe we are nearing the end of the school year. We have got lots of exciting events to look forward to this term, these include the PTFA Summer Fair, our trip to the seaside and Sports Day!

Below are just a few reminders for this term:

Reading

A gentle reminder that children are expected to read daily at home. Children get a new phonics book every Monday. Please send their yellow reading record, phonics book and sharing book into school each day. It is the children's responsibility to change their sharing book if they need to.

Water bottles

Children should bring a water bottle to school each day to keep in the classroom and access when necessary.

Uniforms

We would like all children to take pride in their school uniform. Children are expected to come into school in appropriate school uniform each day, wearing sensible black shoes. Please do ensure children do not wear jewellery to school for health and safety reasons. An exception is made for small stud earrings in pierced ears and small objects of religious significance. English & Phonics

In English we will be writing non-fiction texts using the skills we have learnt over the year. We will be planting bean seeds and writing instructions on how to do this. Following our Geography trip we will be producing a leaflet on Deal and the things we can do at the seaside. Following the Phonics Screen Check in Week 2 we will continue to teach Phase 5 graphemes and tricky words.

Computing

In Computing this term, we are learning how to stay safe online. Children will be taught what the internet is and how it can be used safely.

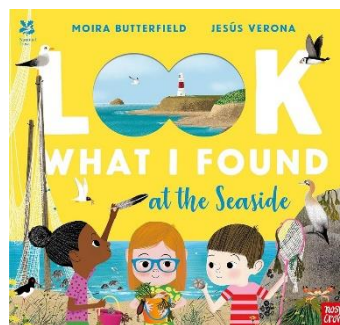
RE

This term we will be exploring vocal and body sounds. We will be learning that music can be used to represent an environment.

Geography

We will be exploring why we love living by the seaside. Children will identify the differences between rural, coastal and city areas. We will be going on a field trip to the beach to explore the human and physical features of geography in our local area.

PE

We have PE every Monday and Friday. Children should wear PE kit to school on those days with appropriate footwear. On these days any studs should be removed or covered up with plasters/ medical tape to prevent injuries.

Maths

In Maths this term, we are learning place value to 100, money and time.

Science

In Science this term we will be looking at the seasons focussing on Summer. We will observe seasonal changes, the weather and how the length of day changes in Summer.

Art

This term we will be exploring aboriginal art. We will learn different techniques to create our own final piece of art work including dot printing and brush strokes. Children will also create their own clay model.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about changes. We will discuss the changes we have gone through from birth to now. We will discuss boys and girls bodies and learn the correct names for our body parts.
