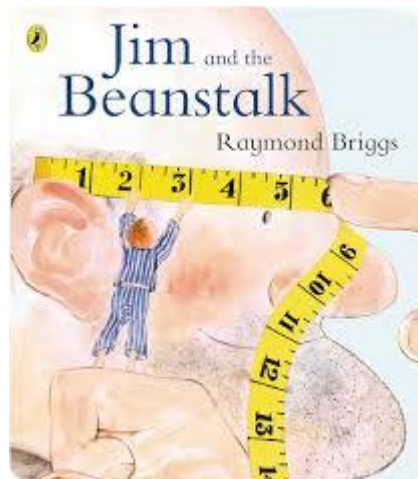
English

This term the children will be creating newspaper reports with inspiration from Jim and the Beanstalk. The Children will develop their knowledge of the features of newspaper reports in order to write their own.

In spelling, we will focus on the use of prefixes and suffixes.

The expectation is that the children read daily to an adult.

Maths

The children will be extending their knowledge of place value by recognising the value of each digit in a three-digit number. We will then move onto addition and subtraction. They will learn how to add three single digit numbers and add two-digit numbers. They will use methods such as bridging through ten, which can be a useful strategy when solving problems.

Science

This term the children will be learning about Light. We will look at different sources of light, why we need light and how light travels.

Computing

The children will learn to differentiate between fact, opinion and belief online. We will look at why social media platforms are age-restricted.

RE

The topic this term is 'What makes us Human'. They will share their personal worldview and identify the difference between personal and organised worldviews.

History

This term we will be studying Romans, Saxon's and Vikings. We will be studying settlements.

French

The children will be learning about instruments. By the end of the unit pupils will be able to recognise, recall, remember and spell up to 10 instruments with their definite article.

PE

This term the children will do dance, where they will learn how to combine movements to create a short sequence. In tennis, they will focus on ball skills and serving.

PSHE

We will be covering the topic 'Being in my World'. The children will identify positive things about themselves and set personal goals.

Music

The children will learn to recognise minims, crotchets and quavers. They will perform rhythms accurately from notation and layer them to create a composition.
