We consider beliefs, practices, wisdom and morality, and community and belonging.

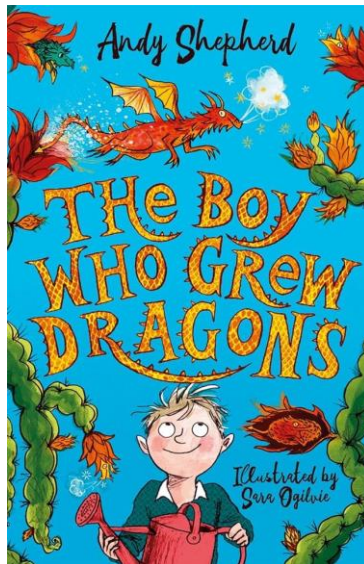
### PE
