### PE

We will be developing the overall body strength, co-ordination, balance, and agility needed to engage successfully with future physical education sessions and other physical disciplines including dance, gymnastics and sports. Developing children's small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely, and confidently.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Children will sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody.

We will use materials and colours purposefully and with control.

### Understanding the World

This term children will recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways. They will also recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.

### Communication and Language

This term we will be focusing on asking questions to find out more and to check children's understanding about what has been said to them. Develop social phrases and engage in story times.

### Managing Self

Independence - resources. Confidence-try new activities and making choices. Responsibility – class resources. Communicate own needs. Keep healthy –tooth-brushing.

### Self - Regulation

Communication – children will recall experiences and make and explain their choices. Children will understand how others feel, they will share experiences and discuss how these are similar and different.

### Maths

Our Maths lessons this term will delve into simple shapes and their structure. We will begin to look at sides, corners and positioning. We will also be looking at numbers to 5 and how we can subitise, represent and form these.

### PSHE

#### Celebrating Difference

We will be exploring what makes us and our families unique by looking at different family structures, homes and cultures.

### Music

We will explore, use, and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings. We will explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.
