Our indoor PE will be Dance on Mondays and we will be doing Tri-Golf outdoors on Thursdays.

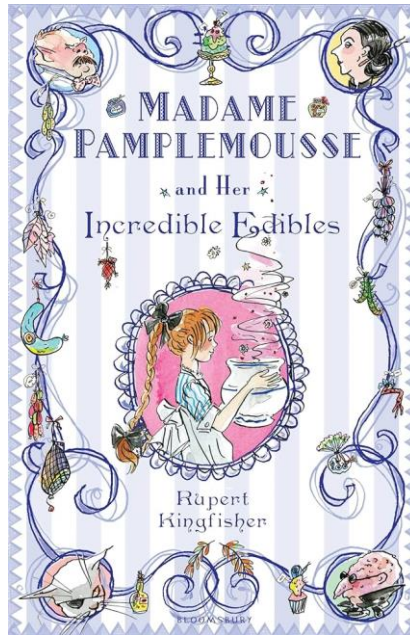
