

English

This Term the children will be studying the text 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. They will be developing a variety of reading skills such as inference, prediction and summary. The children will also be learning the features of a diary and learning to write their own diary based on the text.

This term we will also be exploring persuasive texts in forms of posters, articles and letters

Maths

The children will be adding and subtracting fractions and finding fractions of amounts. They will also be working with money; converting between pence and pounds and finding change. Our final topic this term is time, children will be exploring how to tell the time and explore using a clock.

Computing

The children will explore the programming application 'Scratch'. They will learn to use loops, make and animation and program a game.

Science

This term, the children will be learning about plants. They will learn the parts of plants and what plants need, how water is transported through plants, flowers and life cycles.

French

Recognise, recall and spell 10 ice cream flavours. Ask for an ice cream in French using 'je voudrais'. Say what flavour they would like and whether they would like a cone or small tub.

History

This term we are looking into Ancient Egypt. Exploring the importance of the River Nile and the process after death, including the pyramids

Music

This term we are looking into Instruments and improvisation within the Indian music culture

PE

This term the children will be taught Tri-Golf. Working on their hand-eye coordination and aim. They will also be learning to play rounder's, improving their aim, throwing and team work.

PSHE

The children will discuss family roles and responsibility, friendships, keeping safe online, being a global citizen and celebrating the relationships in their lives.
