English

We will be taking a trip out to visit some religious places around Deal later this term, please keep an eye out for the letter.



ART

PE

PSHE

This term our topic is: Changing Me. We will be focussing on self/body image, what puberty looks like for girls and boys, understanding conception and looking ahead to their next and final year of primary school.

Maths

In Maths this term, we are learning how to draw, read and interpret line graphs in statistics; read and plot coordinates on a grid. How to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimal numbers and understand negative numbers.

Geography

In Geography this term we will be answering the question: Would you like to live in the desert?

The children will learn what a hot desert biome is, where deserts are located around the world, the physical features, how they are used, the threats posed to them and finally come to their own conclusions as to whether they would like to live in a desert.

Science

In Science this term we will be learning about Animals including humans, specifically human growth and puberty which will link with our PSHE lessons.
