

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back, we hope you had a lovely break. Please see below for a few updates:

Our PE days will be Tuesdays and Fridays. Please ensure all long hair is tied up every day. Homework will be sent home on Fridays and be due in on Thursdays. This will consist of spellings that will be tested on a Friday. There will also be a Maths task to be completed online at Atom Learning, once new log-ins have been created. Reading books should be read daily for a minimum of 20 minutes, and recorded in Reading Records. These can be filled in by pupils and then checked by a parent/carer. They should be brought to school daily.

The children will be bringing home a trombone or trumpet in early September. This is part of their 'Bold As Brass' music tuition. Lessons take place in school every Tuesday morning, we would expect the children to bring their instruments in every Tuesday and take them home again to practice. Our focus texts this term will be a poem called *The Magic Box* by Kit Wright. We will be identifying features, planning ideas and creating our own poems and boxes.

We are going to be learning about Online Safety this term, focusing on the importance of strong passwords, online reputation and being safe online.

PE



We are focusing on netball skills leading to a game on Tuesdays and Handball skills progressing to games on Fridays.

Maths

In Maths this term, we are learning about place value, addition and subtraction and we will start to look at multiplication and division.

History

We will be learning all about the Ancient Greeks such as where and when they lived, who lived on Mount Olympus, how they used government and democracy, the philosophers and their impact and the legacy left behind by the Ancient Greeks.

Science

In Science, we are going to be learning all about Earth and Space. We will specifically be learning about the rotation and revolution of the Earth and other planets around the sun and the phases and movement of the moon.

PSHE
