Dear Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of the penultimate week of this half term, we can look back and feel proud of the learning our children have achieved this week.

The children have been really enjoying their P.E. sessions on Tuesdays, which are led by our sports coaches from Team Theme. This week, the children immersed themselves in playing hockey and learned the importance of holding the stick correctly in order to control the ball.

Year 6 had a very successful Parents' Evening, where we discussed each child's progress. We are extremely proud of how hard the children are working to become secondary school ready. Information regarding the rest of the school's Parents' Evening will be sent out after half term.



Last term, we applied for a National Education Nature Park Grant, which offers up to £5,000 to eligible schools to enhance biodiversity and connect young people with nature. As part of a £15 million initiative, the funding supports "grey to green" projects such as planters, trees, and wildlife habitats. We are delighted to announce that our application was approved, and we have been granted the full £5,000.

This money will be used for a nature project in the pond area, which will allow us to open it up properly as a nature garden. This will support a range of habitats and provide children with opportunities to explore the pond environment. This project will support children's learning in Science, Geography, and outdoor education skills.

Thank you to the parents who attended our Year 2 reading workshop. If you were unable to attend, the information will be shared in the coming days. Next week, we will be holding a workshop for Years 3–6. Please come along if you would like to find out more about how to support your child with their reading.
