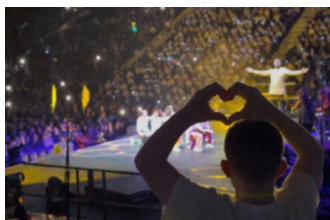


Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a busy first week back, with lots of exciting things happening around the school.

On Tuesday, forty of our children travelled to the O2 in London to perform at the Young Voices concert alongside 8,000 other children, making it the largest choir performance in the world. After lots of hard work learning the words and practising the dance moves during lunchtime rehearsals, the children performed beautifully. They were also lucky enough to watch some fantastic performers on stage, including Ruti, winner of the singing show, The Voice.

As always, we are incredibly proud of the way our children represented the school. A huge thank you to Ms Atkins and Mrs Barrows, who worked so hard to make this wonderful opportunity possible for the children.



As part of our ongoing review of processes, we will be sending out information next week, regarding how we can best support families in ensuring children come to school every day. By working together to maintain attendance above 95%, we give every child the very best opportunity to thrive both academically and socially.
