### English

Over the next few weeks, we will be developing skills to write a recount leading to a new ending. Children will be rehearsing their knowledge of present and past tense verbs, expanded noun phrases and adverbs. After this, we will be focusing on writing to inform using 'Planet full of Plastic.'

### Science

Our science focus this term is plants. We will be exploring the lifecycle of plants, through observation and experiments, and examining what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

### RE

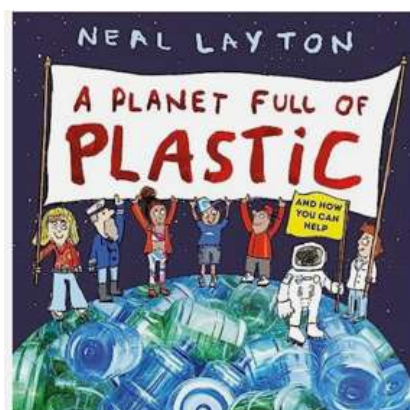
In RE this term we are learning 'What is a Prophet?'. This links to our previous unit exploring why some people are thought to have a special connection to a god.

### Maths

This term, we will be continuing our focus on multiplication and division, building on their addition and subtraction knowledge. Towards the end of term, we will be learning about length and height, capacity, mass and temperature. We will continue to practise our 2-, 3-, 5- and 10-times tables. Please can you support your child at home by practising these regularly.

### History

Our History topic is 'Why did we learn to fly?'. We are looking at the history of flight from the Wright brothers, Amelia Earhart and Bessie Coleman, to why the moon landing was special. So far, the children are really enjoying it!

### Music

From this week, we will be starting a new unit *Dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs*. We will be using a space theme to make our own music soundscape.

### PSHE

This term we are starting a new PSHE unit called *Healthy Me*. Themes around how to make good decisions about staying healthy will be explored across the term.
