English

In English we will be reading 'The Tear Thief' by Carol Ann Duffy. This beautiful text looks at how we deal with emotions and gives the children opportunities to explore the rich, poetic language and develop dialogue.

Maths

This term, we will continue to focus on multiplication and division in our maths fluency lessons. We will continue to learn about mass and capacity, as well as fractions. Towards the end of term, we will learn about money and time.

RE

We will explore the question: 'Why is water symbolic? The children will make connections between religious stories and the importance of water, as well as Identifying how water is used in some rituals and suggesting what water might symbolise.

History

This term we will be asking the question 'What was important to the Ancient Egyptians?' We will be identifying Ancient Egypt's location and its key geographical features, explaining why the River Nile was important to ancient Egyptians, understanding the importance of gods and goddesses to people in Ancient Egypt and learning about mummification.

PE

This term children will be participating in rounders and Tri Golf. They will recap and further develop their techniques and skills in both sports.

Computing

This term, children will be investigating and learning about Scratch and using it to make a simple animation, combining motion, speech and wait blocks, as well as testing and debugging animations to fix problems and improve the code.

Music

This term we will focus traditional instruments from India and improvisation.

PSHE

This term we will 3 we will discuss relationships. These lessons explore how to solve issues with friends, how to help others feel part of a group and how to know and show what makes a good relationship.

DT

In DT, we will be using cross stitch and applique techniques to make and decorate their own Egyptian collars.
