By working with a charity called [Magic Breakfast](#) we are able to provide a free breakfast to **EVERY** child in school – regardless of their family’s financial situation. Breakfast Bagels

In order to deliver this provision, we will be setting up “Breakfast Bagels” across the school for any child that wishes to take part. Starting on Monday 18 March, freshly-warmed bagels will be delivered to each classroom at 8:45 am every day, served by our very own “Magic Breakfast” team. When children come into the class, any child that wishes to may take a bagel and eat it whilst doing their early work.
