Walmer Castle Project

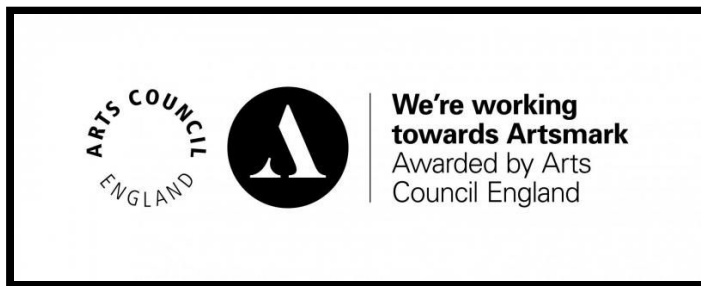
