What are we learning this term?

This term we are learning all about Autumn, Superhero's and Christmas. We will go on Autumnal walks, observe the changes outside, collect leaves and look at spider webs. We will then move onto learning about Superhero's, starting with Supertato. As a learning hook we will design and create our own Supertatoes. We will also begin to use our phonics knowledge to write our first sentences, writing initial, middle and last sounds that we can hear in each word. Our writing will be about superheroes and super powers. Once December comes we will move onto Christmas as our key topic. We will practise our Christmas play 'Angel Express' along with creating Christmas decorations and cards. In maths we will be looking at 2D shapes and learning all about corners and sides.
