



Title: Amazing Africa

Year: 2

Subject Focus: Art, English and Music

Rational:

Through this unit the children will understand that there are many different artists around the world. They will investigate Ghanaian art and artists to give them a greater understanding of different cultures. They will use the Ghanaian artists work to inspire their own creations including masks and a multimedia picture.

Start Date: 7th June 2021

End Date: 16th July 2021

Opportunities for Home Learning:

Find out facts about Ghana, develop a creative piece of work, for example a poster or a model.
Compare Ghana to England.
Create fact files about the artists.

How will we use Bloom's Taxonomy to deepen learning:

The children will ANALYSE and EVALUATE Ghanaian art and then APPLY their knowledge of different artists inspiration and methods to CREATE their own work of art. Through their study of Ghana and the artists who live there they will gain an UNDERSTANDING of different artists and cultures.

Outcome:

Create a mask and a multimedia work of art based on the Ghanaian artists' work.

Hook:

Bigfoot drama group experience.

Sharing Success:

Outdoor display of art created – art gallery for parents to view.
